

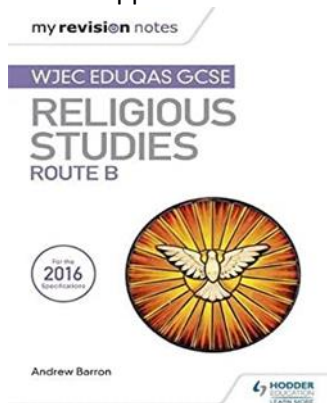

Being Organised

Every pupil will be given a white revision guide published by Hodder. This guide covers all three components. THIS IS THE BEST PLACE TO START REVISION. Pupils must bring this to the weekly revision lesson (marked in bold on the six week plan).

Pupils will also be provided with a task booklet for each component. These booklets will be used for homework tasks.

Pupils have been given three folders, one for each component: Judaism – red, Foundational Catholic Theology - purple and Applied Catholic Theology – blue. Pupils should keep paper resources and exercise books in these folders. At present pupils should keep their Foundation Catholic Theology and Judaism folders at home. They only need to bring in their current Applied Catholic Theology folder.



Independent Revision

Pupils will also be given model answers to exam questions. They should read these to gain a deeper understanding of exam structure and to supplement their classwork.

The Hodder revision guide has questions in green boxes at the end of each section. They are a useful revision tool.
