Key Advice for Exam Preparation / Revision	<p>Make sure you have complete secure knowledge of all key terms and understand 'what the spec says' link so you know which key terms will be needed for which question types.</p> <p>AO1 knowledge needs to be known thoroughly. Use flashcards, mind-maps from your notes.</p> <p>AO2 can be revised by working through a high number of examination questions. Ask your teacher to keep checking extra work (anything above and beyond the guided hours work and in-class tests) on these to ensure you are applying your knowledge to the scenario in a way which is clear to the examiner.</p> <p>AO3 can be worked on by making sure you always 'signpost' to the examiner before you make your point. Practice some smaller strengths and weaknesses questions as well as the essays.</p>
Activities to complete	<p>Detailed cue cards for all key terms from all topics.</p> <p>Completion of past paper questions from the AQA website with a particular focus on your areas of weakness.</p>
