Yr 8 Art and Design Summer Assessment Plan 2025

a. Summer Assessment Requirements

Rationale:

The content links directly with the current SoW/Project and builds on student's knowledge and understanding of Graphic Novels. The examination requires students to demonstrate their technical drawing in sketching accurately from a secondary source and applying their knowledge of the anatomy of the human head and technical technique in using tonal shading in graphite and pen. Students are required to draw and record accurately with precision, testing skills learnt in HT4/5 in the 'Graphic Novels' SoW.

The examination format is differentiated by design through students being able to select their source material. Higher students will be encouraged to select more complex sections and less confident students, simpler compositions to enable all students to succeed.
