a. Summer Assessment Requirements

Rationale:

The content links with skills and techniques that have been taught and developed in year 9 and builds on student's knowledge and understanding of drawing. The examination requires students to demonstrate their technical drawing in sketching accurately from a secondary source, understanding of composition and applying their knowledge of drawing and techniques in tonal shading. Students are required to draw and record accurately with precision, testing skills learnt in HT4/5 in the 'Fashion Illustration' SoW.
