Subject: Classics

Key Advice for Exam Preparation / Revision	<p>Every student has two folders (exercise books) which contain the contextual knowledge, student's own work together with exemplar responses, intervention ideas and Green Pen responses. These should be carefully organised into the two areas covered: Greek Theatre and The World of the Hero (The Odyssey and The Aeneid). Students should have an excellent working knowledge of this information and catch up with any work that they have missed.</p> <p>THIS IS THE BEST PLACE TO START REVISION.</p> <p>Each student will also be issued with revision guides to cover each of the topics studied that have additional material to further aid revision; these include subject content, exam questions, model answers, revision tips & exam technique. This includes guidance for the prescribed texts.</p> <p>Independent Revision</p> <p>Alongside all of the work covered during the course and the revision materials, students could independently access the online materials listed below. In addition to this, students should also fully utilise their textbooks and revision materials as well as clarifying any points with their teachers.</p>
Activities to complete	Students should complete the Christmas homework set by their teacher (The Aeneid themes booklet) and follow up any gaps in their current knowledge.
